



## 2009-10 Hawai'i Veterans Memorial Fund\* Scholarship Application

### Eligibility Requirements:

1. **Classified** undergraduate student enrolled **full-time**.
2. Financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. Resident tuition status (excludes non-residents, military exempt, foreign exempt, and faculty exempt).
4. Must be a U.S. citizen.
5. Must meet the Kapi'olani Community College's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy.
6. Must have character and qualities indicative of good citizenship.

### Application Procedures:

Besides this form, and a FAFSA, the following materials *must* be submitted to the Financial Aid Office:

#### ***New Applicants***

1. Submit a personal statement exemplifying your character (i.e. educational and career goals, extra and co-curricular activities, commitment to serve Hawaii and its people, and/or work experience).
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a non-relative (instructor, counselor, employer, minister) who has recent knowledge of your performance, achievement and character.

***Renewal Recipients:*** Submit this form, a personal statement AND a *recent* letter of recommendation.

**Deadline:** *Applications will be considered based on fund availability.*
