International Student Scholarships

International Academic Achievement Scholarship (Fall 2009): for International students (non-immigrant status) who are enrolled full-time at Kapi`olani Community College (or in their last semester) in a degree seeking program with a minimum GPA of 3.25; must have earned at least 12 credits at KCC; and submit a personal statement addressing any extracurricular activities/accomplishments, participation in volunteer programs, as well as educational and career goals.

International Student Leadership & Service Scholarship (Fall 2009): for International students (non-immigrant status) who are enrolled full-time student at Kapi`olani Community College (or in their last semester) in a degree seeking program with a minimum GPA of 2.50; must have earned at least 12 credits at KCC; and demonstrate outstanding leadership and service to the community as described in a personal statement detailing their extracurricular activities/accomplishments, and participation in volunteer programs (i.e. Service Learning, International Club, etc.); as well as educational and career goals.

Health Sciences Scholarships

Dental Assisting Scholarship Fund

Supports and recognizes new and continuing students in KCC's Dental Assisting Program. Criteria: Admitted/enrolled in the Dental Assisting program; show some degree of financial need; provide a statement of Educational goals & career plans in Dental Assisting; satisfactory academic performance.

Health Careers Student Aid Award

Established in 2006 in memory of Harry and Miyako Fujikawa, this scholarship provides financial aid awards to KCC students with some degree of financial need, pursuing a degree in any Health Career field (health sciences, nursing, or emergency medical services). Criteria: Academic merit with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Preference will be given to graduates of Kaimuki High School (first) and then a Hawaii high school.

Dr. M. Lou Hefley Scholarship

Dr. M. Lou Hefley has established this scholarship to help support a deserving student with some degree of financial need enrolled in the Health Sciences program at KCC. Preference will be given to an applicants enrolled in the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program. Applicant must be enrolled full-time in a Health Science Program, demonstrate academic merit with a minimum GPA of 2.0; and provide a statement of career/educational interest and goals.

Lloyd/Moore Foundation Scholarship for Radiologic Technology Students

The Lloyd/Moore Foundation has established an annual scholarship to be awarded to a second-year KCC student with some financial need and pursuing a career in Radiologic Technology. Applicants must be enrolled full-time, performing satisfactorily towards the Associate of Science Degree in the Radiologic Technology Program; and submit a statement of educational/career goals.

The Queen's Health Systems Native Hawaiian Health Training Scholarship Fund

The Queen's Health Systems has established a scholarship to be awarded to students who demonstrate a strong commitment to the improved provision of health services in Native Hawaiian communities and the State of Hawaii. This scholarship is open students who are pursuing a health science profession in Hawaii and are enrolled in a Health Sciences program at Kapi'olani Community College. Must be enrolled full-time as determined by the department with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher. 1st and 2nd year Health Sciences Students will be considered.

Barbara Felix Yap

Established by students, friends & family of Barbara Felix Yap in her dedication, commitment and co-founding of the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program at KCC. Applicants must be enrolled in PTA program full-time and completed the first year; be making satisfactory academic progress; submit a statement reflecting career goals in physical therapy, showing interest in improving the quality of physical therapy care in the community through participation in community based programs.

Nursing Scholarships

Jane H. Sato Katayama Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist nursing students who have successfully completed at least one semester within the KCC nursing program. The scholarship will be awarded based on academic merit and some degree of financial need.

The Dora Locascio Kapi'olani Community College Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2006 to provide financial assistance to students with some degree of financial need who are seeking a degree in Nursing at KCC. Applicants must be a Hawai'i resident, have a minimum GPA of 2.50, be seeking a degree in Nursing at KCC and enrolled full-time or part-time (minimum 9 credits).

Murabayashi Foundation Scholarship

Through contributions from the Murabayashi Foundation, a scholarship has been established to assist Korean speaking students with some degree of financial need in the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing Program (RNP). Student must be able to speak Korean; be enrolled full-time or part-time in the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing Program (RNP); and provide a statement of career/educational interest and goals.

P.E.O. Chapter C Scholarship in Practical Nursing

This scholarship will provide financial assistance in support of the attainment of a Certificate of Achievement in the Practical Nursing program at KCC. Applicant must be enrolled and performing satisfactorily in the Practical Nursing Program and submit a statement of educational goals and career plans in Practical Nursing.

Alice Oda Tamura Scholarship in Nursing

This scholarship was established with preference to assist nursing students who are single parents or single head of household and who have some degree of financial need.

Kuilei Chancellor's Scholarship:

The Kuilei Chancellor's Scholarship supports recent high school graduates from the State of Hawaii Department of Education system who have the potential to thrive at Kapi'olani Community College. The scholarship gives preference to students from populations that are under-represented in higher education as identified by KCC. There are four (4) - \$1,000 scholarships available.

Eligibility and Criteria include:

- 2009 Hawaii State Department of Education high school graduate
- Priority to residents of Hawai'i; citizens of eligible Pacific Island district, Commonwealth, Territory or insular jurisdiction, state or nation which does not have public institutions of higher education that grant baccalaureate degrees
- At least 6 credits enrollment at Kapi'olani Community College
- Completion of the **Kapi'olani Community College High School Scholarship Application**. Apply using the below links.
- Personal statement demonstrating commitment to higher education and how you plan to give back to society.
- Two letter of recommendations (excluding family members) demonstrating the applicants qualification for the scholarship.
- Admissions to Kapi'olani Community College
- Must apply for financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. If you have not yet applied for financial aid please do so at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Interview with the KCC Kuilei Chancellors Scholarship Committee

If awarded the scholarship it will be disbursed in two semesters (\$500 Fall 2009 and \$500 Spring 2010). To receive the second disbursement recipients will be required to:

- ❖ Register in a First-Year Experience course, such as IS 103, Learning Communities, ACE Cluster, during 1st semester.
- ❖ Strongly encouraged to conduct at least 3 campus tours
- ❖ Meet with Kuilei High School to College Connections Program coordinator at least twice a semester
